

- Councilmember Boone said the Personnel Board meeting will be at 5:30 p.m. this month.
- Councilmember Conyers said the Library Board and the Historic Preservation Committee held their meetings for April; and the Fairhope Environmental Advisory Board will be on April 13, 2018.
- Public Works Director Richard Johnson brought up the HVAC issues at the Nix Center; and the necessary equipment could be bought through U. S. Communities Buying Group with a cost of \$166,000.00. The two biggest air handlers in the ballroom and the fresh air unit are the main issues. Lance Cabaniss commented the fresh air unit is needed; and is suffocating the system. The City Council questioned if this could be bid out.
- Councilmember Brown gave an update on the Pedestrian and Bicycle Committee: back end parking, 3-foot rule for bicycles, upcoming "Parking Rodeo", bike racks, bike valet, and bike to school.
