The following was found and confirmed on Friday, September 28, 2018 concerning the Special Referendum to vote on whether or not to change the City of Fairhope's form of government:

Pursuant to the Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-43A-3, due to the Probate Court's certification being received on July 13, 2018, and because July 13th was within 120 days of a General Election scheduled for November 6, 2018, the referendum was required to be set for a vote on the day of a General Election and could not be legally held on any other date. This is reason the date had to be changed to be a valid election.

Therefore, on November 6, 2018, the City of Fairhope along with the General Election will hold its Special Municipal Election.

I am enclosing another application if you still need to vote absentee. If you are in town and/or able to vote on this new date, you will be voting at your normal precinct (place) where you vote for the General Election. The City will have at least one voting machine at each precinct (place) we have a citizen who votes there. That way, you will only be voting at one place.
