The minutes of the September Committee meeting were approved.

Nancy Anderson reviewed the Fairhope Fall Festival recycling exhibition.

Dale Linder reported that the Mayor has indicated that the City will improve its tracking of waste management operations, and that Public Works will count its recycling participants in the coming 30 to 90 days.

Nancy Anderson previewed the arrangements for the upcoming America Recycles Day, Saturday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, from 8 a.m to 2 p.m. The event will include document shredding and electronics amnesty.

Dale Linder introduced guest Kahley Malloy who has experience as a waste management consultant and is a prospective member interested in our recycling objectives.

Nancy Anderson previewed the arrangements for participation in the upcoming Fall Festival on October 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>.

The Committee unanimously resolved to recommend to City Council an auction of thirty excess City property bicycles as part of Fairhope's America Recycles Day.

The committee had a series of wide ranging discussion of issues having to do with improving recycling service and increasing resident participation. These touched on matters including barriers, models, and school programs.

The next meetings were set for 1:30 p.m. at the Fairhope Public Works Building, Conference Room, 555 South Section Street, Fairhope, Alabama 36532, on November 12 and December 10, 2014.

The meeting adjourned for the work of subcommittees which then adjourned at 3 p.m.
